


7. Program Safety / Great opportunity to experience the country for the first time

In order to be considered for CHI's STEP, an applicant is required:



The program price for Short Term Enrichment Program (STEP) varies depending on how long an applicant plans to stay in the U.S. and these are the program fees:

*Deposit of Program fees: If you confirmed to join STEP program, please pay the program deposit HKD \$6,000 for the booking/confirmation of our processing of your application. The fees are applied towards the program fee balance. In the case of where we are unable to find a placement after 6 months, applicants are able to receive their booking deposit refunded in full if they wish to withdraw.
